

THE NICHE

2014 Cabernet Sauvignon

Variety:	Cabernet Sauvignon
Region:	South Australia
Alc/Vol:	13.5%
Colour:	Crimson with a dark purple hue.
Bouquet:	Aromas of blackcurrant, black olive, dried plums and spices.
Palate:	The palate is full of flavour and generous. Concentrated dark berries with some cassis notes that give this a classic cabernet tone. It is a medium weight wine with balanced acidity, well- integrated tannin and a hint of vanillin on the finish.
Winemaking:	The fruit was picked in the cool of night then fermented on skins in static potters and rotary fermenters for a period of six days, to create a good balance between extracting the appropriate tannin for wine structure and retaining fruit drive and aromatics. Following the pressing process, clarification and final blending the fruit was matured with select parcels having contact with old French and American oak.
Cellaring Potential:	Drinking superbly upon release although will age over short to medium term.
